- Challenges of Biomedical Research in Africa








Challenges reported:

Communication

- Problems with Internet connection / telephone network,
- Community engagement
- Intra-network communications (WG scheduled calls)

Challenges reported (Cont'd):

Training

- -More co-ordinated training for LIMS & IT management for project staff
- -Continuous skills audits
- -Orientations / Induction of new staff

Logistical

- -Transportation from laboratory to study sites
- -Delays in getting laboratory materials/reagents

Challenges reported (Cont'd):

Quality Control / Monitoring

- Poor documentation, reporting, tracking & archiving for project audit

Host Institutions

- Low level of support / Commitments not met
- Bureaucracy

Ethical issues

- Broad consent
- Delays in gaining approval
- Participant recruitment (how to motivate & retain study participants)

Other issues and challenges faced by study co-ordinators

- **Ebola outbreak**
- Availability of PIs
- WG Scheduled calls, more participation

SO, WHAT DO WE DO?

Challenge or Issue	Possible solution
Communication	Investigate different service providers, high-speed internet modems to supplement internet connection. Explore new methods of community engagement from other SCs
Training	Training / skills audit, establish a training record for project staff, identify relevant people in Education & training WG
Logistical	Adequate planning
Quality Control / Monitoring	Establish appropriate Quality management systems
Host Institutions	Establish better communication with relevant stakeholders at the institution
Ethical issues	Evaluate different scenarios at various sites, explore viable & appropriate incentives that can be used in community
Ebola outbreak	
Availability of Pls	Delegation of responsibility
WG Scheduled calls, more participation	Provide alternative daytime telephone numbers
